## **Museum News**



If you can't make it to France for this year's Le Mans race there is an alternative. You can join other Corvette Racing diehards in the Chevrolet Theater at the National Corvette Museum for a viewing party. This theater is one of only 3 locations around the world with a commercial free, uninterrupted feed of the race. The date is June 16-17 and you can check the Museum website for more information. You can now make your Mondays a little merrier with a new online series-Moore

Mondays. Each week Museum Curator Derek Moore will share with viewers the history of a car, whether at the Museum or on location. The features will be a combination

of Facebook Live videos (usually around 10:30 am CST) and produced videos posted to You Tube and Facebook. The racing simulator has arrived and is located on Corvette Boulevard. It offers visitors of all ages the chance to sit behind the wheel of a real C6 Covette to pilot the car around a virtual race track. The car recently received a new yellow wrap and racing decals from Pratt & Miller. Sessions are \$10 each and there are no age restrictions. Passengers are welcome too. The 2019 Corvette ZR1 is the Official Pace Car for the 2018 Indianapolis 500 and will lead drivers to the green flag on Sunday, May 27th, for the 102nd running of this legendary race. It is the 15th time a Corvette has served as the Pace Car since 1978, and the 29th time a Chevrolet has led the field, dating back to 1948. No other vehicle has served s the Pace Car more than the Corvette.

The Corvette Racing Team of Oliver Gavin and Tommy Milner won back-to-back races in Southern California. It was the 107th class victory all-time for Corvette Racing and the first of its 20th season of competition.


