Museum News



The NCM exhibits the history of the Corvette from its inception to current year. They utilize their artifact and archive collections in the galleries to tell the Corvette story. These goals are accomplished with the help and support of enthusiasts. One way that enthusiasts can support the NCM's mission is by donating a vehicle to the collection. They are currently looking for several Corvettes to add to their collection, as well as several other cars that have a significant tie to the Corvette story. The annual Vets 'n Vettes event at the NCM and NCM Motorsports Park kicks off on Thursday, November 8 with a full day at the Motorsports Park. Registered event attendees get free laps at the track in exchange for offering Corvette rides to veterans. A complimentary lunch is also served. There are also a number of events on Saturday and Sunday, November 9-10. To see the full schedule check out the Museum website.

Corvette has long had the nickname 'America's Sports Car' and according to the annual Kogod Made In America Auto Index, it is also the 'Most American' made vehicle with a top score of 83.5 points.

Each October the NCM teams up with the Kentucky State Police to lead a special fundraising event. The proceeds from the event are split between the Museum and the Kentucky State Police's Trooper Island Camp, which is a free of charge, week long experience designed to help underprivileged kids.


