# **Museum News**



NCM is bringing back three high performance drivers' education events in 2017. There is almost no change to the event dates but there are some slight format changes in an effort to bring more value and track time to everyone. April 27/28 is the Michelin National Corvette Museum Bash HPDE, June 26/27 is the National Corvette Museum HPDE at VIR, and Aug. 26/27 is the National Corvette Museum 23rd Anniversary HPDE. Registration is open and you can get more details on the Museum website.

The High Performance Drivers Introduction (HPDI) is a "101" on track program that introduces new drivers to recreational performance driving. There are three dates, March 26, May 13, and September1. Details of the program and registration information is now available on the Museum website.

February 12th marked the 3rd anniversary of the sinkhole at the Museum. Initially the Museum planned to put the past behind them but interest in the sinkhole and the damaged Corvettes has been undeniable. On Thursday, Feb. 9th, the 1962 Corvette that was still covered in dirt and debris from the sinkhole, was removed from the display and transferred to a garage bay where it will undergo restoration work to bring it back into shape. The work will be performed at the Museum and guests will be able to see the car's progress. You can also track the progress on Facebook and YouTube where videos that provide updates will be posted.

The Museum has named a new Curator. He is Derek Moore of Garrettsville, Ohio. He previously served as the Crawford Curator of Transportation History at the Western Reserve Historical Society in Cleveland, Ohio. His duties include researching, developing, and producing exhibits as well as the planning, acquisition and/or loan, safekeeping and cataloging of collection objects and vehicles related to Corvette history.

Registration is open for the NCM Bash & Museum in Motion scheduled for April 27-29, 2017. See the Museum website for details.

# **CCWP Lap—Woodward Dream Cruise**



In 2017 the CCWP Lap is planning on traveling out of state again, this time actually a week long event. We are planning on going up Tuesday, August 15th and staying through Saturday, leaving Sunday the 20th. About one million people attend this event each year. It's all about cars and cruising, partying with friends, people and car watching, and then more cars. There is no fee to drive in the cruise and no admission fee to watch the show. There is information about the cruise available on the website visiting Michigan for the Woodward Dream Cruise.

The date of the actual cruise is Saturday, August 19, 2017, but it is http://woodwarddreamcruise.com. There is a gentleman that organizes a number of tours and events for Corvette owners and we are going to include a number of these in the agenda. We are also looking into the possibility of touring the Ford museum while we are there.

Jan Hollabaugh was generous enough to step up and take care of our accommodations. She has reserved a block of rooms at the Somerset Inn, 2601 West Big Beaver Rd. Troy, MI 48084 for us for the dates Tuesday, August 15 through Saturday, August 19. There are 2 types of rooms. Tower rooms are on floors 3 through 14 and they have 1 Queen or 2 Double Beds and the cost is \$105 per night plus taxes (about 13.3% combined) for a total of about \$119 per night. Executive Wing rooms are on the 1st and 2nd floors and have either 1 King or 2 Queen Beds and the cost is \$130 per night plus taxes for a total of about \$148 per night.

If you are interested in joining us you are responsible for making your own hotel reservations. You can call The Somerset Inn at 800-228-8769 or 248-643-7800 and be sure to reference the block of rooms held for CCWP to get these rates. Please call as soon as you can because rooms are going fast and the hotel is not sure how long they can hold them. You can always cancel if you can't go. At last count there were only 4 rooms left. There is more planning to come, and we typically have meetings the third Tuesday of the month at Pasqualino's Restaurant in Murrysville. Join us for the next meeting March 21. Come at 6 pm to join us for dinner with the meeting to follow at 7.
