American drivers aren't the only ones who like their Vettes. The first allocation of 250 mid-engine 2022 Corvettes with right-hand drive straight from the factory has already sold out in Australia. The initial batch is slated to be built in the Bowling Green Assembly Plant during the second half of the year, with delivery possible just before Christmas or early next year. Even with future allocations taken into account, the number of new Corvettes is likely to remain small. Some customers paid \$20,000 to \$40,000 above MSRP to make sure they were among the first in Australia to own right hand drive mid-engine Corvettes, in some cases driving the price over \$200,000.

Chevrolet has sent the first allocations for the 2022 Corvette model year to their dealers. Allocations could be impacted by the fact that because Europe and the United Kingdom are slated to begin receiving 2022 export models as early as October. Chevrolet has told dealers that production of the 2022 Corvettes is expected to begin the week of September 27th, a little later than what was initially expected.

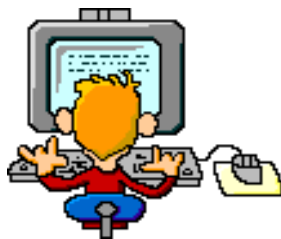

This year the NCM will be celebrating its 27th Anniversary. The Anniversary Celebration will be held Thursday, September 2nd through Saturday, September 4th. Online registration is open. Registered attendees can look forward to enjoying three fun days of activities in and around the Museum. There is an option to attend virtually where registrants will have access to a virtual feed of the seminars and presentations.

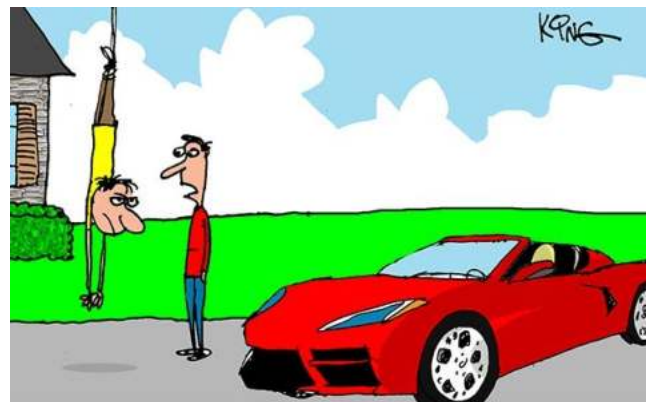
Treasurer—Mike Diorio
